<p>RE – Judaism</p> <p>Create a poster showing some important beliefs in the Jewish religion.</p> 	<p>Geography – Local study</p> <p>Collect some data about your local area and show this in a graph.</p> <p>(If you collect data on traffic – let an adult know what you are doing)</p> <p>Which types of vehicle use your road?
