

Reading

Your child will now be receiving a sound blending or Red Ditty reading book which is linked in with their phonics level. Please encourage your child to read this to you as many times in a week as possible.

Please continue to practise all your sounds and then use them to build words. Ask your child to make the words, telling them how many sounds they will need e.g. 3 sounds for the word dog. Can they hear the sounds and make the word? Sometimes swap roles and you make a word and ask your child to Fred talk it and read the word to you.

English

We will be learning stories using actions in order to be able to retell them. We will create story maps of the events in each story and children will have a go at creating their own story maps and writing. Stories will include 'Quackling' by Pie Corbett.



Maths

We will continue to use the CBeebies programme 'Numberblocks' to teach understanding of the numbers and the number system. We will be exploring numbers 6-10. Comparing groups up to 10 as well as further exploration of addition and subtraction.



Phonics

We will be following 'Read, Write Inc' as a method of learning our phonic sounds, and how to use them to read and write. Children are grouped by ability and work with other children who are the same level as themselves.
